Shop!

In the early hours of Saturday morning (14/8/21) there was a break-in, in the shop. The matter was reported to the police and a forensic officer dusted for fingerprints. We have since discovered that other sites have also been targeted by thieves.



Two strimmers were removed, plus accompanying safety equipment. The shop and the green shed had been vandalized and an attempt was made to break into the neighbouring container. The shop was accessed with the use of an angle grinder to cut the lock. So far as we can tell, the very old container and the yellow container were not interfered with.

Several lockers in the green shed appeared to have been opened. If you had any belongings in them which are no longer there, please report them to the committee in order that we can build a fuller picture of what these vandals stole.

We conducted a visual inspection of plot-holders' sheds but none of them appeared to have been tampered with. Please take this as a gentle reminder not to leave any items of value on your plot.

Unfortunately, we have had to temporarily close the shop until we repair the damage and obtain new locks. We hope this does not cause too much inconvenience.
