#### **USE OF HOSEPIPES!**

Please remember that the use of hosepipes is restricted to filling water butts and watering cans. It is not permitted, as per Birmingham City Council rules, to use hosepipes for directly watering crops. This applies to all tenants!

#### **FLOODING**

The exceptionally bad weather we have experienced recently, has resulted in a number of plots becoming flooded.

We reported this to the Council and they have since, sent out a Gully Sucker out to clean the drains. Unfortunately, however, there appears to be a blockage in the main line just outside our area, which the Council are looking into.

In the meantime, please could anyone who has a plot bordering the access road to remove weeds and debris – to allow the rainwater to run more freely into the drains.

#### ACCESS ROAD MAINTENANCE!
