PLOT-HOLDER'S FEEDBACK UPDATE

Thank you to the 54% that returned the Feedback Questionnaire. We are embarking on a five year plan for improvements to the site, based on your comments and suggestions. Things already set in motion include:

A) The fence on the A₃8 is now in situ.



- B) The road drains have been cleared and checked some remedial work remains to be undertaken at the contractor's end.
- C) We aim to clear vacant plots with flooding issues and are seeking advice on rectifying this problem.
- D) The feedback included improving on-site facilities, providing a more of a community environment. We have costed relocating the two green containers to the area behind the porta cabin and for the porta cabin to be turned 90 degrees facing the grassy area to the right of the gate. This is currently ongoing.

IMPORTANT NOTICE!!

Sadly, we need to draw your attention to the fact that there have been a number of minor thefts and other incidents on site recently. These range from missing fruit and produce to someone defecating in a plot-holder's poly tunnel. If you are aware of similar incidents on your plot, please inform a Committee member. Furthermore, if you see anything suspicious, please let a committee member know as we are logging all incidents. It is worth mentioning that some of these incidents occurred after the fence adjoining the A₃8 was erected.

Also, let a committee member know if you are planning to release your plot. For information, sub-letting is not permitted under Allotment Rules.
